How to get to Amigo Hall

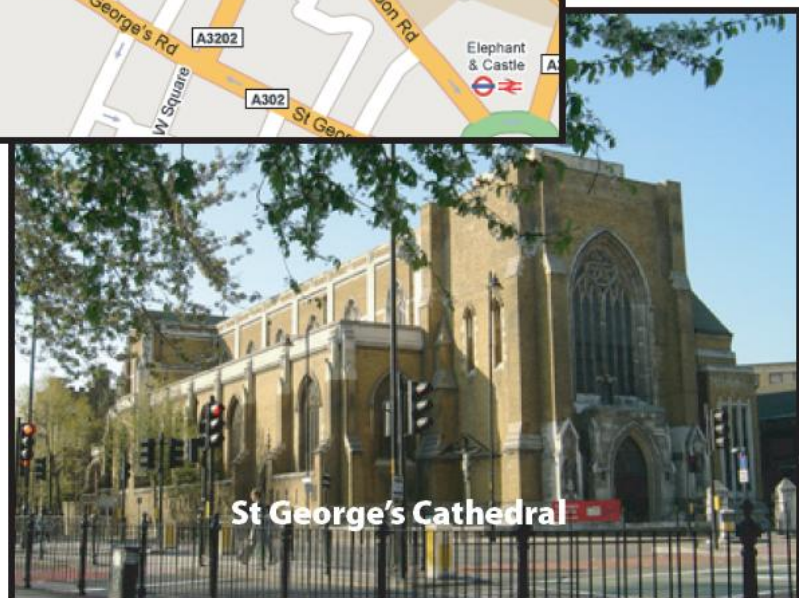
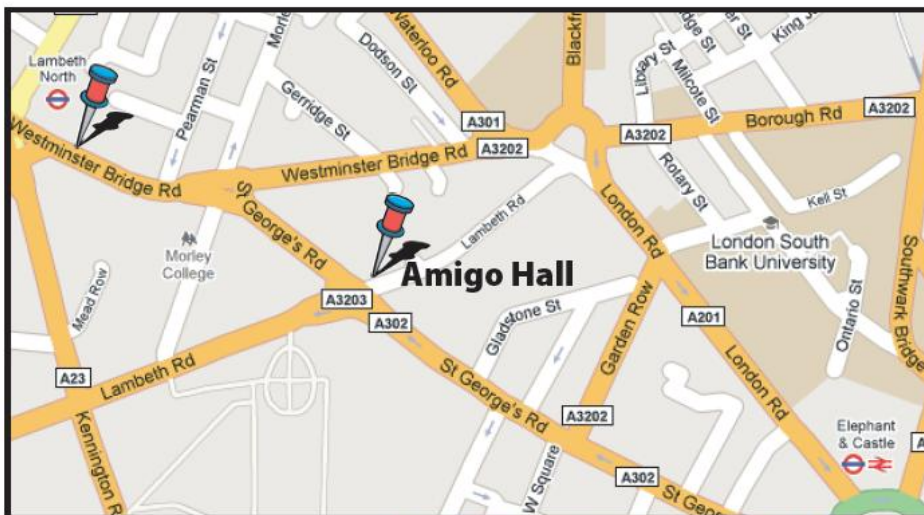
Amigo Hall is next to St George's Cathedral on Lambeth Road (SE1), at the intersection with St George's Road.

By tube

Amigo Hall is within easy walking distance of Lambeth North underground station (Bakerloo line, marked on map below), Waterloo station (Northern and Bakerloo lines), and Elephant & Castle station (Bakerloo and Northern lines).

By bus

Numerous buses serve the area, including no. 59, 1, and 12.



Amigo Hall is adjacent to the Cathedral, immediately on the right (separate entrance).
